1 1/2hr bat trail in Leckhampton

Please join us for a Bat Watch led by LEGLAG in the beautiful Leckhampton countryside. Dr Elizabeth Pimley, local ecologist and LEGLAG member will begin with a short talk then it's off to survey the hedgerows and fields to see and hear which bats species are out and

about.

Start: Junction of Brizen Lane & Farm Lane, Leckhampton GL53 (Parking on Brizen Lane)

If on the night it's raining heavily the bat walk will be cancelled as bats don't like to come out in heavy rain (a bit like us)! We think that this event is suitable for all ages, but we urge you to wear appropriate footwear and bring a torch. Children must be accompanied by an adult.
